Rules & Regulations [Stud]

- **Cattle to be ready for NLIS scanning at 8.30am, with National Vendor Declaration Form/Travelling Stock Statement/Waybill**
- Johnnes Disease status declaration to accompany all entries
- Full particulars regarding breed, age, colour, pedigree and name of beast must be provided on the Stud Beef Entry Form
- Classes listed will be held for all breeds
- All Beef cattle must be haltered
- All bulls 12 months and over must have a nose ring
- Heifer to be under 2 years and not to have had a calf, unless otherwise stated
- All stock must be registered with recognised breed society
- Association ribbons will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd. If more than 5 entries in any class
- Champion Male & Female sashes may be awarded for all breeds. All ribbons will be awarded at the discretion of the judge
- The age of all cattle to be the actual age up to 1 September 2011
- Calves under 8 months may accompany mother whilst being judged
- Please complete a **separate entry form** for each **breed**
- All Cattle to have NLIS devices

Stud Classes – Each Breed

Class 1 Female 8 months and under 16 months

Class 2 Female 16 months and under 24 months

Class 3 Female 24 months and over

2.3 The cattle originate from a beef herd that qualifies as *Beef Only* Please attach *Beef Only* declaration for cattle originating from herds located in the Control Zone.

2.4 Where applicable the cattle identified above which are 2 years of age or older originate from a Non-Assessed herd and have been blood tested (or where the cattle are less than 2 years of age the dam has been tested) by a registered veterinarian using the absorbed ELISA test with negative results within 6 months before the date of the show / sale / exhibition (as certified in Part 3).

2.5 The cattle identified above originate from Restricted (RD) or Tested Low Prevalence (TLP) herds that are under strict regulatory control and:

- Have been undertaking official, audited test and control programs for a minimum of 2 years; and
- At least 2 consecutive annual whole herd tests have been conducted with a reactor rate not exceeding 1.5% at the latest herd test; and
- The cattle to be exhibited, or their dams, have been tested with negative results as part of at least the last two annual herd tests; and
- The cattle to be exhibited are not officially listed as 'at risk' cattle for the particular herd; and
- The cattle to be exhibited have been tested negative within 3 months of the date of the show.

Exhibitors may also need additional certification to move between zones or between states. Check with your local veterinary authority. The above information, including the description of the animals and property(s) of origin is complete, true and correct.

Monitored Negative (MN) – the herd has an Assessed status under the Australian Johne's Disease Market Assurance program for Cattle (CattleMAP).

Beef Only – the herd satisfies the criteria for this classification.
